Chairman D'Amico called the Workshop Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

#### E. Public Hearing

PH 1 – Consider Resolution No. 2020-01 – Amending Certain Existing Job Descriptions for the Exotic Plant Removal Spray Technician

Resolution No. 2020-01 was presented, entitled:

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2020-01**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE ST. LUCIE WEST SERVICES DISTRICT AMENDING CERTAIN EXISTING JOB DESCRIPTION FOR DISTRICT EMPLOYEES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Pickle advised that everyone was already aware of the changes and this item did not require any further explanation.

#### F. Public Comment

Gary Smith, a Kings Isle resident and representative of "People Serious about Litter," indicated he was present at today's Workshop as a follow up to his attendance at a previous meeting. He thanked Bill Hayden and Gerard Rouse for responding to his request for a location to dump items they pick up. He also noted that there was a meeting later today at the Chamber of Commerce for people who were concerned about litter and indicated that the Mayor was also getting involved with the program to make Port St. Lucie the cleanest city.

# G. District AttorneyDA 1 – Status Report/Updates

Mr. Pickle noted that there would be a walk-on item at tomorrow's meeting requesting authorization to publish a Notice of Qualifying Period for the upcoming election.

That concluded Mr. Pickle's updates.

# H. District EngineerDE 1 – Status Report/Updates

Mr. Pickle was not aware of any updates from Mr. Lawson.

## I. District Manager Action Items

#### DM 1 – 2019 Annual Drinking Water Quality Report

Mr. Miller presented the 2019 Annual Drinking Water Quality Report, indicating that copper and lead testing is only done every two years.

Supervisor Graci asked how the District's water compares to the City's to which Mr. Miller responded that it was only a matter of taste and that all levels were safe.

#### DM 2 – Other Items/Updates

Mr. Pickle addressed an issue regarding allowing other organizations the use of the District's meeting room. He indicated that the new Administrative building was still 7 to 12 months from being completed so there was plenty of time to come up with a policy. He indicated that there would be no tax implications if the District only charges the cost to care for the facility during usage. He also noted that the attorney had warned against allowing too many groups to use it and that it should be kept to only HOA-type groups.

Supervisor Grazi gave a summary of how the Cascades handles permitting usage of the clubhouse, noting that no religious or political groups are able to use it.

Mr. Pickle suggested limiting meeting room use to only SLW groups.

Mr. Pickle noted that he had met with the aqua range people (CGI) and representatives from Country Club Estates and indicated that there was no funding as of yet. He furthered that the Utility Fund could loan the money to the General Fund and then raise assessments to pay it back. He also indicated that they could extend the water management bond by one year to 2026 and would fund improvements.

Mr. Pickle indicated that the property at California would cost approximately \$500,000 to make buildable. He noted that once that had been done, it could sell for approximately \$1.7 Million.

Chairman D'Amico asked if they could use the dirt from the aqua range to fill the California parcel. Mr. Pickle indicated it depended on its quality. Mr. Pickle noted that the range would cost about \$400,000 to dig and would be between 8 and 10 feet deep.

Supervisor Graci expressed concern over potential obstacles they will have with selling the California land. Mr. Pickle indicated that he had met with the City 2 years ago on this item and that they expressed their support if the community supports it. It was noted that it might be a difficult task, given that the intersection is already very busy.

Vice Chairman Ney indicated he liked the idea of extending the bond, out of the options given. Secretary Doughney agreed with Vice Chairman Ney.

Secretary Doughney asked if we could do the interfund transfer and then extend the term to pay it back quicker and keep working on California to fund everything. Discussion ensued.

#### **Summary**

Provided for your review and consideration is the Bid Proposal for the Replacement of the Existing Filter #2 located at the Wastewater Treatment Facility. District staff received (3) Three bids to furnish all materials, equipment and labor to perform this project on February 13, 2020.

Attached for your review is a bid results summary of the seven bids received ranging from \$804,700.00 to \$984,500.00.

The lowest responsive bid received was from Lawrence Lee Construction Services, Inc. whose office is in Stuart, Florida. Staff reviewed the bidder's references as well as past projects like this one and recommends that the Board consider an award to Lawrence Lee Construction Services, Inc. in the amount of \$804,700.00.

The Wastewater Treatment Facility Filter #2 Replacement Project was budgeted using both the Wastewater Connection Fee Fund \$300,000 and the Utility Fund Wastewater Budget Capital Outlay Building Code \$405,000. A budget Amendment of \$135,000.00 from the Utility Unrestricted Fund Balance will be needed to complete this project.

#### Recommendation

Staff recommends approval for the Budget Amendment #2020-03 of \$135,000.00 from the Unrestricted Utility Fund Balance to the Utility Fund Wastewater Budget Capital Outlay Building Code and approval of Bid Proposal from Lawrence Lee Construction Services, Inc for the Replacement of the Existing Filter #2 located at the Wastewater Treatment Facility for the not to exceed price of \$804,700.00.
